CAPRIVI SECONDARY SCHOOL - OVERALL WINNER OF 2015 BANK OF NAMIBIA NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL COMPETITION

The Bank of Namibia is proud to announce the winners of the 2015 National High School Competition which concluded with a final gala event on Thursday, 13 August 2015 at the NamPower Convention Centre. The winners are as follows:

Overall winner: Caprivi Secondary School, Zambezi region

2nd runner up: Etosha Secondary School, Oshikoto region

3rd runner up: Ponhofi Secondary School, Ohangwena region

4th Runner up: Jan Möhr Secondary School, Khomas region

As an overall winner, Caprivi Secondary School scooped a cash prize of N\$50 000-00, while Etosha Secondary School walked away with N\$30 000-00. Ponhofi Secondary School was awarded N\$ 10 000-00 and Jan Möhr Secondary School received a printer for their school.

The Bank of Namibia National High School Competition takes place after every two years. The 2015 Competition attracted an impressive 205 schools from all over the country compared to 201 in 2013. Learners from grade 8 to 12 were invited to partake in the regional phase of the competition which was conducted from 1st – 14 July 2015 in all the 14 regions. To enable the learners to adequately prepare for the competition, schools were provided with competition brochures and necessary resource manuals. Learners formed teams of four that represented their particular schools under the guidance of a teacher. In the regional phase of the competition, the following 14 regional winning teams emerged and travelled to Windhoek to participate in the semi-finals which were hosted at the Bank of Namibia on Wednesday, 12 August 2015:

At the final event, learners competed in front of a panel of judges and a live audience. The competition was conducted with a buzzer system with the team pressing the buzzer first having one minute to the respond to the question posed.

The 8th Bank of Namibia National High School Competition was highly commended by the Ministry of Education represented by Mr. Milton ya Otto, Inspector of Education in the Khomas region. He noted that this competition continues to expose many learners to the workings of the economy and significantly improving learner's knowledge on the role of the Central Bank in the economy.
